Issues to be addressed at this meeting include the following: (1) Draft Marine Aquaculture Policy Statement and proposed legislation; (2) Deepwater Coral Research Plan; (3) Ecosystem Modeling Coordination; (4) Status of FEP development; and (5) Draft List of Items for the Fishery Ecosystem Plan Comprehensive Amendment.

Marine Aquaculture

- A. The draft policy statement has been prepared by the Habitat AP and the committee will review and provide staff guidance. It is anticipated that the committee and Council will formally approve at the March 2007 meeting.
- B. Draft legislation is available and staff provided a preliminary response given the deadline. The committee and Council should review and provide formal comments.

Deepwater Coral Research Plan

The FEP teams have provided a draft plan. The committee and Council should review and approve.

Ecosystem Modeling Coordination

A coordination meeting has been held and Dr. Pat Halpin will provide a status report to the committee.

Fishery Ecosystem Plan

Roger Pugliese will provide an update on progress and anticipated completion date.

Draft List of Items for the Fishery Ecosystem Plan Comprehensive Amendment

The Committee and Council have approved a draft list of items to be included (**Attachment 3**). Council staff are proposing some changes to reduce the number of issues to be addressed in the first comprehensive amendment; other items can be addressed in a future amendment. Committee and Council should review, modify as necessary, and approve.
